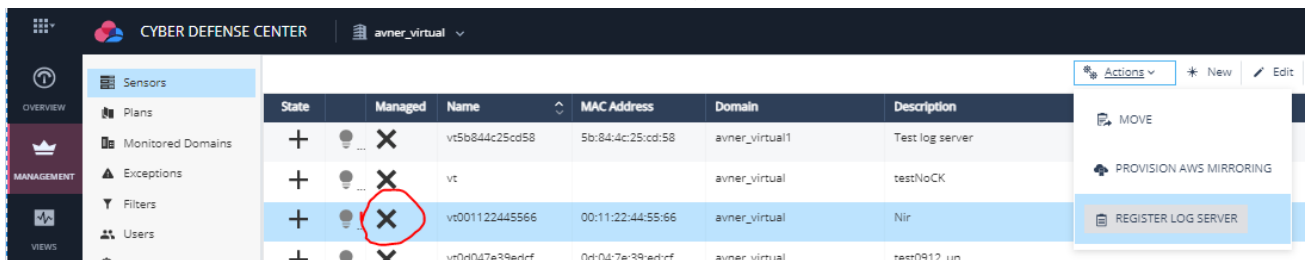


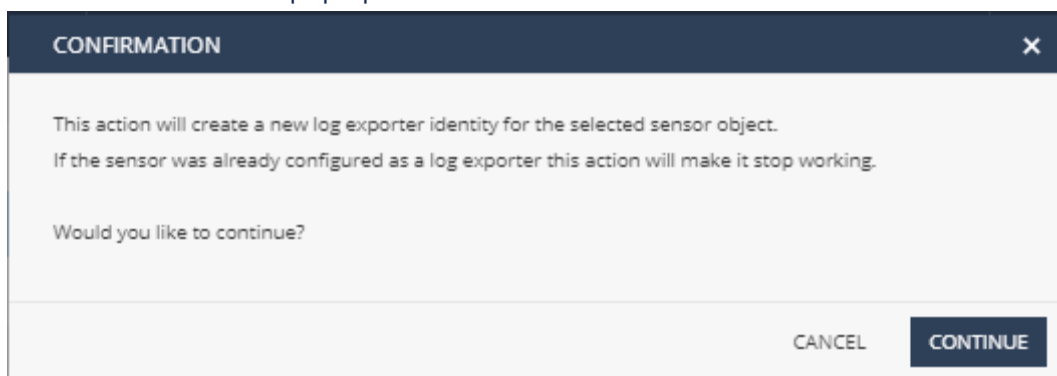
Check Point Network Detection and Response (NDR) Log Server Registration

Onboarding Process:

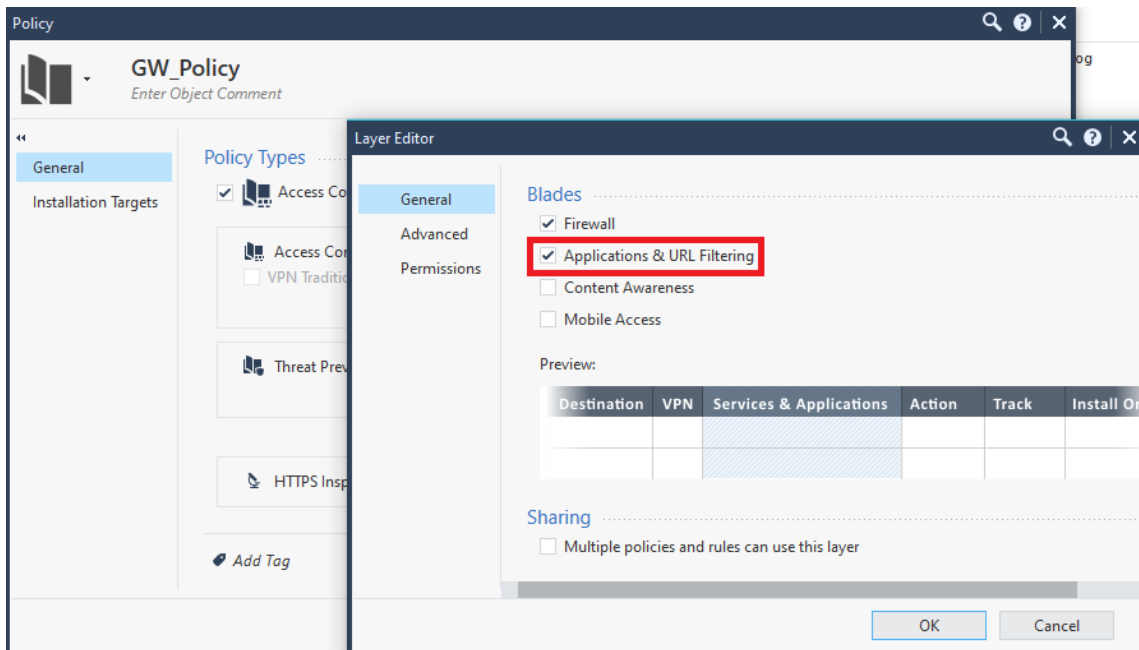
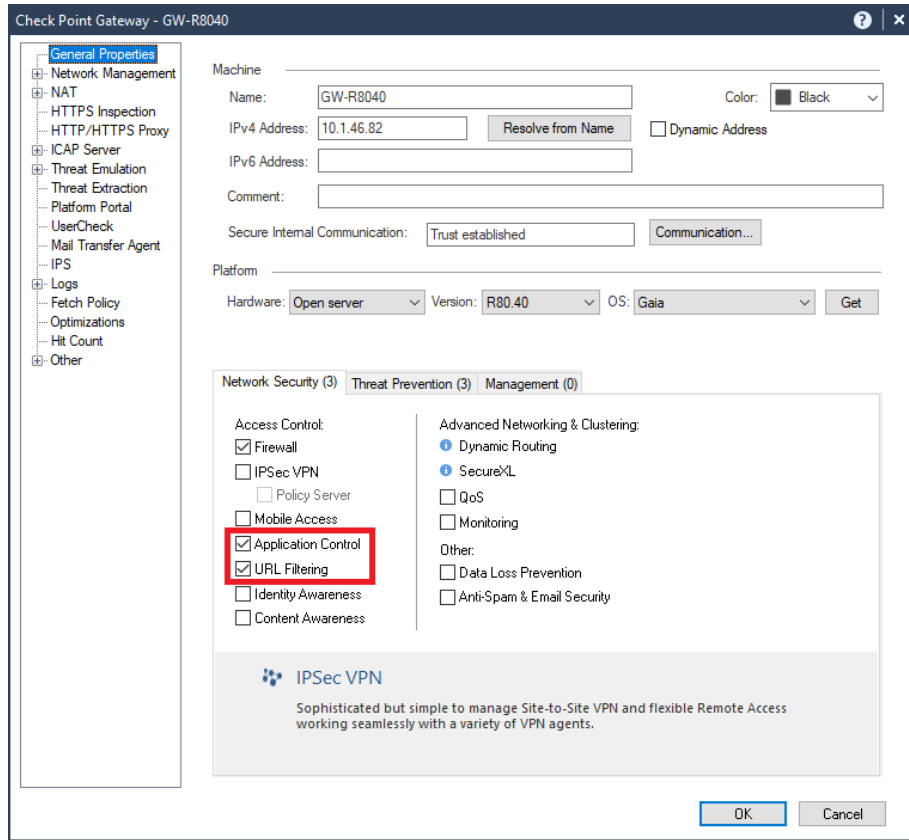
1. If you don't have a domain or access to the Cyber Defense Center (CDC), you should register a new domain by pointing your browser to <https://register.now.checkpoint.com/register>.
2. Once you have access to the CDC, open <https://now.checkpoint.com> and it will let you into your new domain. It will also prompt you to switch to the MANAGEMENT > Sensors page.
3. Click on "New" at the top to add a virtual sensor.
 - a. Unselect "Managed" – to create an "unmanaged" sensor
 - b. Please leave the Sensor MAC blank
 - c. Provide a descriptive name for this sensor in "Description"
 - d. Enter your Timezone
 - e. Click on "ADD"
4. Click on the new sensor entry that you created in order to select it, and click "REGISTER LOG EXPORTER" from the Actions menu.
 - a. Please read the Requirements below before you start this process.



- b. On the confirmation pop up window click "CONTINUE":



Enable APCL/URLF in the gateway object and in the policy:



Then change logging on rules to ensure that Application Control is activated. For example:

No.	Name	Source	Destination	Services & Applications	Action	Track
1		NET_Internal	Internet	* Any	Accept	Extended Log

This will allow your Security Gateway to log application traffic so that it can be analyzed by the NDR service's Behavioral Analytics engines and visualized on the CDC portal.
